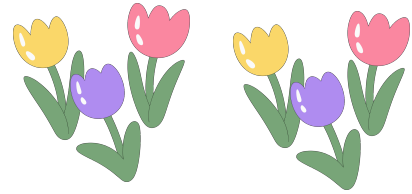

Thunderbird will once again be marching in the Crystal Lake Independence Day Parade! Watch for information coming home soon on how you can participate!

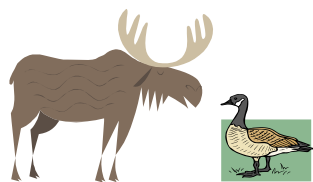

Count off - 3, 4

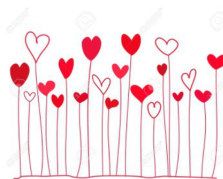
